We had great fun on our Spooky Day for Halloween and leading up to Bonfire Night, talking about Fireworks how to be safe around them and making firework pictures.

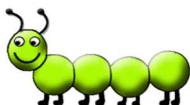

Please let your child's key person know that you wish to attend.

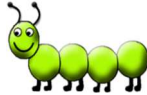
Parentzone

Caterpillars



This month we will be talking about healthy eating we will take a trip to the local supermarket to choose our own fruit and veg to try, we will also have “real” fruit and veg in the home corner for us to role play with.

We will also do some fruit and vegetable printing. We have flashcards with different healthy foods on that we will be looking at and learning their names.

Bumble Bees
